PAYMENTS/LOANS TO DIRECTORS AND RELATED PARTIES AND ASSOCIATES OF

Payments and loans during the quarter to directors and related parties, and associates of directors and related parties, of Grange Resources Limited total \$167,000 and include:-

- Directors' fees (inclusive of superannuation) of \$19,282 paid to non-executive directors of the Consolidated Entity.
- Fees of \$20,000 paid to Hagankellar Pty Ltd, a company associated with a former executive director of the Company, for the provision of services of the former Managing Director at commercial rates (\$20,000 of this amount relates to services provided in the previous quarter).

- A fee of \$60,000 was paid to Asia Pacific Partners for services provided for the period 1 January 2001 to 31 December 2002, a company associated with a non-executive director of the Company.

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
